There is still time to take part if you have any unwanted clothes to aid our project and all of the money raised will be going straight to the NSPCC!



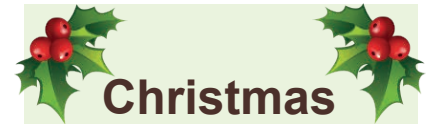
CHILDREN'S CHOICE

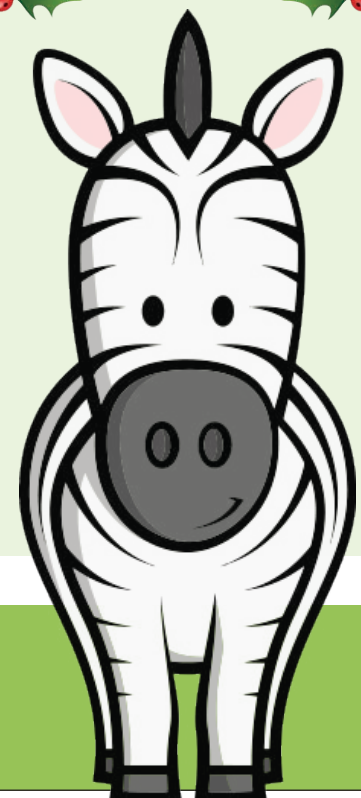
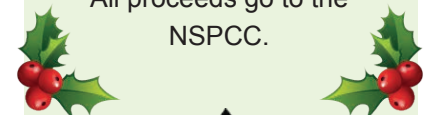
