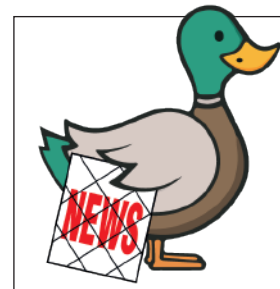




DERBY STREET NEWS FLASH

We created our own zoo and delivery boxes from the story which we enjoyed hiding in and climbing in and out of, and we got our wet suits on and used mud, water and glitter to create our own animal mud bath. The children have been repeating words and sounds from the story, and their favourite animal was the lion.

The Ducklings showed interest in Pirates after looking at a story within their room '10 little pirates'. The children have really been using their imaginative skills as they created some pirate soup in the home corner mixing lots of different ingredients together. We created a big pirate map and made our way around the different numbers to find the treasure and enjoyed decorating the map using lots of paint and our feet.

The Farmers have enjoyed exploring their skeletons which followed on from the book 'Funny bones'. The children have taken part in various activities around our bodies, what our skeletons look like and people who help us. We made salt dough and used it to create our own bones and after excavating them, we created our own skeletons. We looked at x-ray pictures and spoke about x-ray machines and people who help us in hospital. We also had some tadpoles brought in from one of our friends, and we have enjoyed watching and learning about the lifecycle of a frog.

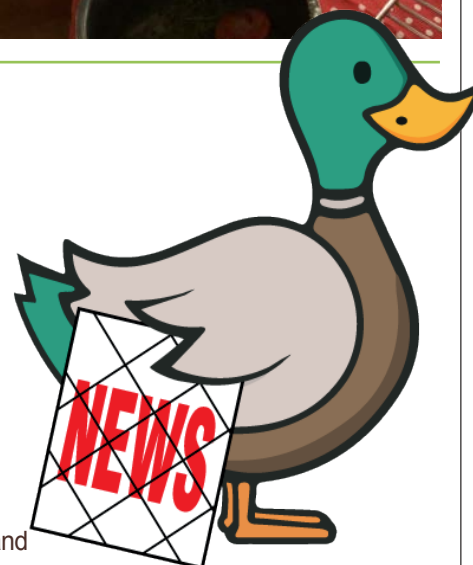
