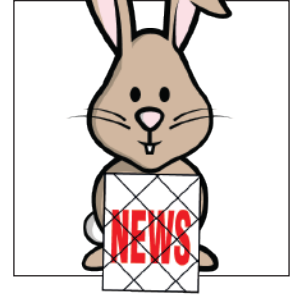

LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

Lambs

We have been learning about colours and we have done this through a variety of activities starting with reading the book 'Brown bear brown bear'. The children were to follow the repetitive language of the story and attempt to repeat words. The children enjoyed taking part in different creative activities such as painting umbrellas with brightly coloured paint, and outdoor activities such as large-scale painting using different resources.

In the lambs we have been concentrating on developing our self-help skills. We have been washing our hands at the children's sinks and taking turns to clear our plates into the waste tub after meals.. This will be continued each day, to build on the children's confidence and co-ordination skills. To celebrate Earth Day the children used different recycling to create a ramp for their cars to go down and we made our very own recycling truck.

Ducklings

In the Ducks we have been learning about change. We have read through several books starting the month with 'Change starts with us', teaching the children about our environment and how we can make changes with our own routines at home and in nursery to make the world a safer and cleaner place. We then chose the book 'The hungry caterpillar'. Each morning and afternoon the children enjoyed sitting and reading the story about the caterpillar and its transformation. We made our own cocoon instruments and painted our own butterflies which we laminated and put up in our outside garden.

We celebrated National Bee Day, we made paper plant pot bees to hang on our tree outside, we also painted a cardboard box orange as our beehive.

Farmers

In Farmers we have been exploring a range of topics this month we have been learning all about life cycles, caring for our environment and have just started our new topic of stranger danger which will lead into road safety and safety at home. We began by linking this topic to 'Goldilocks and the three bears.' We provided a range of activities for the children to take part in such as creating their own beds and chairs at the play dough station, making porridge in the home corner, role playing the story with the characters and accessories and daily discussions about keeping ourselves safe. We also spoke to the children about 'safe' strangers and if we were lost who we could ask for help such as a police officer.

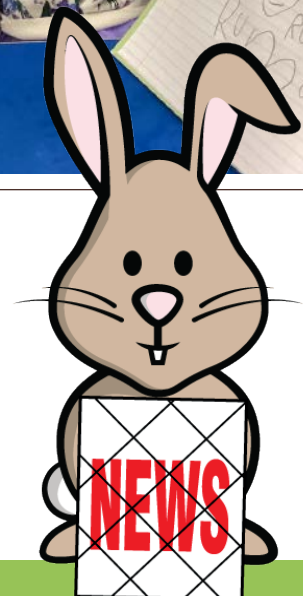
