We had a lot of fun celebrating graduation. The Little Lambs have loved exploring the book of 'The Tiger who came for tea', the children have joined in with lots of activities from the story and got very messy using their senses which they thoroughly enjoyed. The children washed the dolls out in the sunshine and showed recognition of different body parts as they sang their song "this is the way we wash our ", they baked some delicious cakes, had a lovely tea party together, and made sensory tiger food.

The Ducklings and Farmers have been enjoying time outside in the beautiful sunshine. The children have been taking part in lots of physical development activities, creating their own obstacle courses and learning how to balance. They have been large scale mark making using various utensils, spray bottles and animals. We also got creative in our water play area as we created lots of ramps with the water pipes, and made BIG bubbles using bottles as we challenged ourselves to be able to achieve it. We loved splashing our feet in the water! The children enjoyed their book with a hook 'Peter's pebbles', and they brought big pebbles into nursery which we decorated and displayed. They learnt about habitats and where different animals live by using a map as the pebbles came to life in the story and turned into animals. They explored the different foods that the animals may eat and explored where it comes from, and also had a boat race like in the story.
