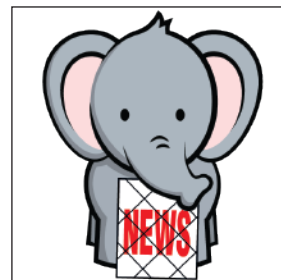

LOOK WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING...

LAMBS

The children have enjoyed exploring our book with a hook 'Leaf man', We introduced the weather change and have spent lots of time playing outside in the sun and rain. We took part in activities incorporating leaves and autumn colours including making their very own leaf man whilst exploring colour change. We also enjoyed our song of the week "All the leaves are falling down" throughout the topic. This helped focus on supporting the children's visual stimulation and creative side. We have also been developing new sensory time ideas and this has been enjoyed by all the babies.

FARMERS

The farmers children have been exploring healthy eating and fitness alongside learning about dinosaurs the past couple of weeks linking to our book with a hook '1, 2, 3 do the dinosaur'. The children have loved making their own salt dough fossils and researching facts about them, melting dinosaur ice eggs and designing their own dino masks. As we have gone on to learn about our bodies and balanced diets, we have explored the seeds from different fruits and vegetables, made our own delicious soup and carried out lots of sensory playdough activities using different smelling herbs. Over the next few weeks we will be exploring Autumn and about looking after our environment and nature around us.

DUCKS

The ducklings have come back from their break and have loved taking part in activities "all about me." We have spoken and done lots of activities linked to what the children like/dislike and how we are all different. This helped the children settle in and for our new starters to start their visits. We did lots of activities and also spoke about how we eat different foods, wear different clothes, listen to different music and live in different houses shaped in different styles.

We will be continuing exploring Autumn alongside our sensory play encouraging the children to explore touch, feel and sound. Please could we ask parents to go on walks in the changing environment, collect items such as leaves and twigs and bring them in to nursery.
