

As a nursery we welcomed our Parents/Carers and Grandparents into nursery to join us for our National Grandparents Day and the big draw festival stay and play sessions. The children enjoyed engaging with their family as they explored various activities together before ending their session with some beautiful singing.

The Little Lambs have been exploring the Autumn season and Halloween. The children have been engaging in activities to support their senses and have enjoyed practicing their transporting, scooping and tipping skills. The children helped to create pumpkin moon sand and created their own pumpkins through fruit printing.

The Ducklings have been using their physical development, imaginative play, and sensory skills as they have explored activities linking to our big draw festival, Halloween, world space week and Autumn. The children have been learning their new Autumn song and poem during key worker time and focusing on new words and objects which link to the season. The children have been practicing scissor and pincer skills as they explored our sensory autumn tuff tray, created their own rockets from recycled materials, explored our new Halloween heuristic basket, created their own magical potions and have taken part in lots of mark making activities. They even had a visit from a skeleton, and the children named him Duncan.

The Farmers have had lots of fun taking part in space week, talk like a pirate day, Autumn and exploring science linking to Halloween. The children created their very own space station. They have been learning all about the planets and the solar system through stories, songs, imaginative play, experiments, and activities linking to the topic we had so much fun.
