LAMBS

The children have enjoyed exploring different textures linked to Halloween and their book of the month 'Peek-a-boo Halloween'. We explored different sized and coloured pumpkins, and we rolled them through paint and then cut them open to see what was growing inside. The children have enjoyed making their own salt dough decorations and making their own Halloween posting games. The children had lots of fun, getting messy and using all their senses to explore.

DUCKS

The Ducklings have enjoyed being introduced to Halloween through the 'Where's My Witch' story. The children enjoyed rescuing the animals from the haunted farm set up in the messy tray, they explored the texture of the webs left by the spiders and were delighted when they found hidden bats and spiders. They had lots of fun making their own decoration for their room and taking part in lots of spooky sensory play.

FARMERS

We have enjoyed the 'We're Going on A Pumpkin Hunt story', exploring the pumpkin in a number of different ways in the water and creative areas. The children enjoyed cutting pumpkins open to explore the seeds and pulp. They took part in pumpkin hunts around the nursery and in the garden. They also made their own pumpkins, using apples and icing sugar.

EXPLORERS

The children have enjoyed the 'Christopher Pumpkin' story as they counted down to Halloween. They enjoyed saving the spiders from the webs using tweezers which supported their fine motor skill development. The children have been learning about the meaning behind the carving of a pumpkin and what it represents. We also spent time dressing up the skeleton and learning about different body types.

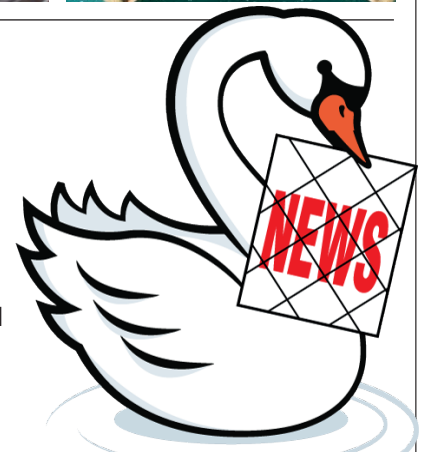
