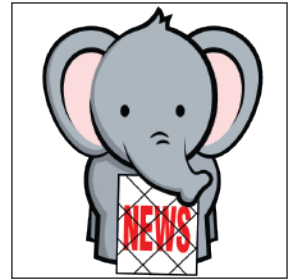




EDINBURGH WAY
